Explanation of Responses:

- Each restricted stock unit represents a contingent right to receive one share of the issuer's common stock. The restricted stock units vest as to 7,921 shares on the date of the meeting of the Company's compensation committee to be held in the first quarter of the fiscal year ended January 31, 2022.
- Each restricted stock unit represents a contingent right to receive one share of the issuer's common stock. The restricted stock units vest as to 3,623 shares on the date of the meeting of the Company's compensation committee to be held in the first quarter of the fiscal year ended January 31, 2023.
- Each restricted stock unit represents a contingent right to receive one share of the issuer's common stock. The restricted stock units vested as to 19,073 shares on March 31, 2020.
- Each restricted stock unit represents a contingent right to receive one share of the issuer's common stock. The restricted stock units vest in four equal installments of 2,059 shares on each of March 31, 2021, 2022, 2023, and 2024.
- Shares held of record by the Stephen and Christine Neeleman Trust.
- Shares held of record by Neeleman Family Holdings, LLC ("Family Holdings"), a Utah limited liability company. The reporting person is the manager of Family Holdings. The reporting person disclaims beneficial ownership of the shares held by Family Holdings except to the extent of his pecuniary interest therein and this report shall not be deemed an admission that the reporting person is the beneficial owner of the shares held by Family Holdings for any other purposes.
- The option is exercisable as to 14,992 shares. The option becomes exercisable as to the remaining 4,975 options on March 27, 2021.
- The option is exercisable as to 7,114 shares. The remaining options become exercisable in two equal installments of 3,557 options on March 27, 2021, and 2022.
- The option is immediately exercisable.
- The option is exercisable as to 3,835 shares. The remaining options vest as to 3,384 shares on each of March 27, 2021, 2022 and 2023.
