Explanation of Responses:

- Each restricted stock unit represents a contingent right to receive one share of the issuer's common stock. The restricted stock units vest as to 1,636 shares on the date of the issuer's annual stockholder meeting held in the current fiscal year; the remainder will vest on January 31, 2019. Vested shares will be delivered to the reporting person on February 1, 2019.
- Each restricted stock unit represents a contingent right to receive one share of the issuer's common stock. The restricted stock units vested as to 223 shares on February 1, 2018. The remaining restricted stock units vest as to 223 shares on May 1, 2018 and August 1, 2018, and as to 224 shares on November 1, 2018. Vested shares will be delivered to the reporting person on February 1, 2019.
- The option is immediately exercisable.
